

# FACILITIES, NEBRASKA STATE COLLEGE SYSTEM

**POLICY: 8006 Vacating Streets**

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## **BOARD POLICY**

When one of the Colleges has determined that it is in the best interest of the institution to request the closing of a city-owned street that runs through or is adjacent to the campus, such proposal shall be submitted to the Board for consideration and approval. Included in the information provided to the Board should be:

- a) rationale for vacating the street
- b) planned use of the street
- c) fiscal impact of vacating the street
- d) city's procedures for vacating the street
- e) results of preliminary discussions with city officials on the proposed closing

After the Board has approved the vacating of a street(s) within a college campus, the required documents to petition for the vacation of specific streets or alleys shall be signed by the President or Vice President for Administration and Finance and then by the Chancellor or Vice Chancellor for Finance and Administration or General Counsel and submitted to the appropriate county or city.
